## **PRICING INCLUSIONS**

This program represents a unique experiential learning opportunity in an overseas environment. It presents the chance to grow academically, and to be part of a new and vigorous commitment to increase global awareness at The Blake School. It is a “rolling program” of academic heft, taking place over 12 days and in 3 distinct regions of China.

Pricing is set at a level designed to defray both academic/program costs and travel costs, as follows:

- Academic program design & delivery. This is an experiential learning opportunity of substance and rigor, tailored specifically to the needs of the Blake School, its students, faculty, alumni, and parents.
- Access to an array of in-country partner schools; educators and academics; civil-society activists; journalists; government officials; social scientists, environmental and ecological experts; family planners; food security advocates; historical & cultural institutes; and service project sites, as described in daily program.
- International airfare, including taxes and fees, and air within China, including taxes and fees. (*Note: A visa, as well as a passport, is required for entry into China.*)
- International-class hotel accommodation, w/ breakfast daily. (*Based on double occupancy; single room is available on request, at an additional charge.*)
- International-class coach transport in Beijing, Shanghai, and Xian.
- Local guiding, program management, and interpretation services, plus all entrance fees to indicated venues.

N.B. Program elements are subject to final confirmation of available in-country experts, school representatives, etc. Rarely, a specific visit or event must be revised or removed; if removal becomes necessary, a visit or event of *equivalent academic value* will be identified and substituted.
